

PRIVACY STATEMENT DISCOM B.V. GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION

Article 1: personal data that is processed

- 1.1 Discom B.V. may process your personal data because you make use of the services of Discom B.V. and because you provide these personal data to Discom B.V. when filling in a contact form on the website. By using the services of Discom B.V., you consent to the processing of your personal data.
- 1.2 Discom B.V. may process the following personal data:
 - a. Your first name and surname;
 - b. Your address details;
 - c. Your telephone number;
 - d. Your e-mail address;
 - e. Your IP address.

Article 2: why Discom B.V. needs these personal data

- 2.1 Discom B.V. processes your personal data in order to be able to contact you by telephone if you so request and/or in order to be able to contact you in writing (by e-mail and/or post) if you cannot be reached by telephone. In addition, Discom B.V. may use your personal data within the framework of the execution of a contract for services concluded with you or within the framework of its promotional activities.

Article 3: how long Discom B.V. retains your personal data

- 3.1 Discom B.V. retains your personal data in its customer database. Your personal data will not be used for longer than is strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which your personal data are collected. Your personal data will be retained even if no contract is concluded with you.

Article 4: sharing your personal data

- 4.1 Discom B.V. will only provide your personal data to third parties if this is necessary for the execution of a contract with you, or to comply with a legal obligation.

Article 5: how to access, modify or delete your personal data

- 5.1 You have the right to access, modify, delete or transfer your personal data. You can submit a request for access, modification or deletion to info@discom.eu. Discom B.V. will respond to your request as quickly as possible, within four weeks at the latest.

Article 6: submitting a complaint to the Dutch Data Protection Authority (*Autoriteit Persoonsgegevens*)

- 6.1 You have the right to submit a complaint to the Dutch Data Protection Authority if Discom B.V. fails to comply with the above.

Article 7: security

7.1 Discom B.V. takes the protection of your personal data seriously and takes appropriate measures to prevent misuse, loss, unauthorised access, unwanted disclosure and unauthorised modification. The website of Discom B.V. uses a reliable SSL Certificate to ensure that your personal data does not fall into the wrong hands.
